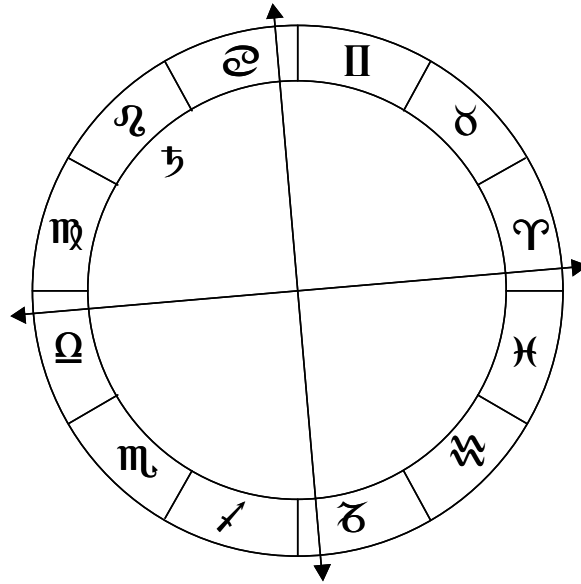
A) Eight differences between traditional and modern astrology

- a) Number of bodies: fewer
- b) Use of Lots: many
- c) Aspects: classical aspects and conjunction; whole-sign configurations
- d) Early emphasis on whole-sign houses
- e) Spiritual component, but no political agenda or mass spiritual evolution
- f) Emphasis on prediction (profections, solar revolutions, transits, primary directions, *firdariyya*, etc.)
- g) Objectivity *versus* subjectivity (use of rules; objective values, events, character)
- h) Location and rulership more immediate than natural signification
